2024 Grant Guidelines

Clinton County Community Foundation is pleased that your organization is considering submitting an application for grant funding for 2024. We want you to be successful in your application process, as well as with your charitable and civic work in our community. Please carefully read all of the information and be sure to contact us with any questions that are not answered herein.

ELIGIBILITY: Eligible organizations must be located within Clinton County or demonstrate that their services benefit residents in Clinton County.

Applicants must be either a governmental unit/political subdivision or a nonprofit organization with a 501(c) designation recognized by the IRS.

BE AWARE: Grants cannot be used for administrative/labor costs.

TIMELINE:

Oct. 16, 2023	Grant application for 2024 will be available on-line at www.clintoncountyfoundation.org.			
Dec. 15, 2023	Applications sent via U.S. Postal mail to CCCF must be postmarked by this date.			
Dec. 15, 2023	5, 2023 Applications that are hand-delivered must be received at Water St. address by 5 p.m. this date			
Jan. 24, 2024	Decisions on all eligible applications are scheduled to be made by the Board of Directors.			
FebMarch 2024	Grant agreements are sent to organizations selected to receive funding.			
March 31, 2024	The deadline by which signed grant agreements must be received by the CCCF.			
Dec. 1, 2024	The deadline by which an evaluative report must be completed by arantees and returned to CCCF.			

COMPLETING THE FILLABLE PDF GRANT APPLICATION FORM:

The 2024 Grant Application for funding by CCCF is provided in a fillable PDF format, which allows applicants to enter data directly into the form using their computer and Adobe Acrobat Reader, so to print paper copies. Following are instructions regarding how to successfully complete the fillable PDF grant application.

- Use only the latest version of Adobe Acrobat Reader to complete the application. Do not complete the application online within your web browser using an alternate PDF viewer, other PDF readers (e.g., Foxit Reader, xPDF), or by using Apple Preview (macOS). Macintosh and Windows versions of the free Adobe Acrobat Reader are available from Adobe at https://get.adobe.com/reader/.
- **Before completing the application**, save the fillable PDF file to your computer (e.g., Desktop, *My Documents* folder).

- If viewing the form online in a web browser using a built-in PDF viewer, right-click in the displayed PDF and select Save as or Save Page As. Make sure Adobe Acrobat Document is selected for the file type (*.pdf), and save the file. Note the file name and location of the saved file.
- Once you have saved the grant application to your computer, you are ready to complete the form in Adobe Acrobat Reader.
 - ✓ Launch Adobe Acrobat Reader.
 - ✓ In Adobe Acrobat Reader, choose **File** > **Open** from the menu bar. Locate the saved grant application PDF file, then click **Open**.
 - ✓ Complete the application, then save the final version of the file to your computer by clicking **File** > **Save** (or **File** > **Save** As) from the menu bar in Adobe Acrobat Reader.
- **HOW TO SUBMIT:** The Foundation requires 11 paper copies of the cover letter, the 2-page application and supporting grant documents, **HOWEVER**, we require just one (1) copy of your IRS 990, your IRS 501(c)3 letter and your Bureau of Charitable Organizations (BOCO) certificate.

Frequently Asked Questions:

What type of projects are funded by CCCF?

Most grant awards provide funds for specific programs, equipment purchases, or capital improvements.

What is the range of grant sizes that have been awarded?

In 2023, the grants awarded ranged in size from \$500 to \$33,000; no minimum or maximum amounts are set.

What is a Taxpayer Identification number (TIN)?

This is the also the Employer Identification Number (EIN).

Why do some funders/foundations only provide grant awards for 501(c)(3) organizations?

The IRS uses the 501(c)(3) designator to denote an organization as charitable. Other non-profits which the IRS determines as not purely charitable may also receive grants, however it is the responsibility of the Grantmaker to ensure that the award was for a charitable project.

Can an organization apply for two different grant projects?

Yes, provided they can accomplish both projects, if funded.

Can I use more space than is allotted for the open-ended questions on Page 4 of the form?

Yes, the fillable PDF is set up to scroll. The question about the problem and needs that will be met allows 4,000 characters in the response, the financial sustainability question allows 1,500 characters, and finally the question on evaluation of the project allows 2,500 characters.

If grant funds are not/cannot be spent within the calendar year in which they are awarded, must the money be returned to the Foundation?

Yes.

Are matching funds necessary to be awarded funding?

While not a requirement, organizations are strongly encouraged to seek out and acquire funding from other sources.

Can I submit my grant application by email only?

No. We require 11 paper copies of the grant application and supporting documents BUT we require just one copy of your IRS 990, your IRS 501(c) letter and your Bureau of Charitable Organizations (BOCO) certificate. Call us at 570.220.1038 with any questions.

How do I get a letter from the IRS regarding my organization's 501(c) status?

If a grant request is for only one item, then does a budget still need to be provided?

Yes. Consider adding into your budget other costs associated with the project such as shipping, in-kind labor, set-up fees, etc. Even if the ancillary costs are not a part of the grant request, when prospective grantees include such additional costs and how they will be covered, they display competence and awareness of big-picture costs.

Are grants awarded to multi-year projects?

Yes. Although grants are typically awarded to projects that will be completed within the year, commitments can be made by the Board of Directors for multi-year projects.
